Solemn declaration by the judges ad hoc

THE HAGUE, 16 February 1999. On Wednesday 17 February 1999, at 9.45 a.m., the International Court of Justice will begin by holding a short sitting in the above-mentioned case during which Prince Bola Adesumbo Ajibola, the judge <u>ad hoc</u> chosen by Nigeria, and Mr. Kéba Mbaye, the judge <u>ad hoc</u> chosen by Cameroon, will make the solemn declaration provided for in Article 20 of the Statute of the Court.

After a short break the hearings in the case concerning <u>Kasikili/Sedudu Island</u> (<u>Botswana/Namibia</u>) announced in Press Communiqué No. 99/2 will resume.
