<u>Application of the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment</u> of the Crime of Genocide (Croatia v. Serbia)

Fixing of the time-limit for the filing of the Counter-Memorial of Serbia

THE HAGUE, 22 January 2009. The International Court of Justice (ICJ), the principal judicial organ of the United Nations, has fixed the time-limit for the filing of the Counter-Memorial of the Republic of Serbia in the case concerning <u>Application of the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide (Croatia v. Serbia)</u>.

By an Order of 20 January 2009, the Court fixed 22 March 2010 as the time-limit for the filing of a Counter-Memorial by the Republic of Serbia.

The Court adopted the Order taking into account the views of the Parties. The subsequent procedure has been reserved for further decision.
