The following information from the Registry of the International Court of Justice has been communicated to the Press:

The International Court of Justice held two public sittings to-day, April 11th, 1951, in the case concerning the Reservations to the Convention on Genocide.

Mr. Kerno, Assistant Secretary-General of the United Nations, concluded the statement which he had begun yesterday. Mr. Rosenne, representative of Israel, then stated the views of his Government on the question. Mr. Rosenne will conclude his statement to-morrow, Thursday, April 12th.
