Territorial and Maritime Dispute (Nicaragua v. Colombia)

The Court to deliver its Judgments on Wednesday 4 May 2011 at 3 p.m. and 4.30 p.m., respectively, on whether to grant the applications for permission to intervene filed by Costa Rica and Honduras in the case

THE HAGUE, 15 April 2011. On Wednesday 4 May 2011, the International Court of Justice (ICJ), the principal judicial organ of the United Nations, will deliver its Judgments on whether to grant applications for permission to intervene filed by Costa Rica and Honduras in the case concerning the Territorial and Maritime Dispute (Nicaragua v. Colombia).

Two public sittings will take place, at the Peace Palace in The Hague, the first, at 3 p.m., during which the President of the Court, Judge Hisashi Owada, will read the Court's Judgment concerning the application filed by Costa Rica and the second, at 4.30 p.m., during which President Owada will read the Court's Judgment concerning the application filed by Honduras.
