IMPORTANT REMINDER TO THE MEDIA

THE HAGUE, 30 June 2004. The Information Department of the International Court of Justice (ICJ) reminds media representatives that the deadline for submitting their online requests for accreditation to attend the reading of the Advisory Opinion of the Court in the case concerning the <u>Legal Consequences of the Construction of a Wall in the Occupied Palestinian Territory</u> (request for advisory opinion) expires tomorrow, Thursday 1 July 2004 at midnight.

After that date, the on-line application form for media accreditation will be withdrawn from the home page of the Court's website (www.icj-cij.org), and it will no longer be possible to request accreditation to attend the public sitting in this case on 9 July 2004.
