## Maritime Delimitation in the Black Sea (Romania v. Ukraine)

## Fixing of time-limits for the filing of written pleadings

THE HAGUE, 19 November 2004. The International Court of Justice (ICJ) has fixed, by an Order of today, the time-limits for the filing of the first written pleadings in the case concerning <u>Maritime Delimitation in the Black Sea (Romania v. Ukraine)</u>, which was submitted to it on 16 September last.

In its Order the Court fixed 19 August 2005 as the time-limit for the filing of Romania's Memorial and 19 May 2006 as the time-limit for the filing of Ukraine's Counter-Memorial.

The Court made the Order taking account of the views of the Parties. The subsequent procedure has been reserved for further decision.
