<u>Dispute regarding Navigational and Related Rights</u> (Costa Rica v. Nicaragua).

Fixing of time-limits for the filing of the initial pleadings

THE HAGUE, 2 December 2005. The International Court of Justice (ICJ) has fixed time-limits for the filing of the initial pleadings in the case concerning the <u>Dispute regarding Navigational and Related Rights (Costa Rica v. Nicaragua)</u>, which was submitted to it on 29 September last.

In its Order dated 29 November 2005 the Court fixed 29 August 2006 as the time-limit for the filing of a Memorial by Costa Rica and 29 May 2007 as the time-limit for the filing of a Counter-Memorial by Nicaragua.

The Court adopted the Order taking account of the views of the Parties. The subsequent procedure has been reserved for further decision.
