<u>Application of the Interim Accord of 13 September 1995</u> (the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia v. Greece)

Fixing of time-limits for the filing of the initial pleadings

THE HAGUE, 22 January 2009. The International Court of Justice (ICJ), the principal judicial organ of the United Nations, has fixed time-limits for the filing of initial pleadings in the case concerning <u>Application of the Interim Accord of 13 September 1995 (the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia v. Greece)</u>.

By an Order of 20 January 2009, the Court fixed 20 July 2009 as the time-limit for the filing of a Memorial by the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia and 20 January 2010 as the time-limit for the filing of a Counter-Memorial by the Hellenic Republic.

The Court adopted the Order taking into account the views of the Parties. The subsequent procedure has been reserved for further decision.
