Request for the indication of provisional measures

The Court to hold public hearings on Monday 30 and Tuesday 31 May 2011

THE HAGUE, 19 May 2011. The International Court of Justice (ICJ), the principal judicial organ of the United Nations, will hold public hearings in the case concerning the <u>Request for</u> <u>Interpretation of the Judgment of 15 June 1962 in the Case concerning the</u> Temple of Preah Vihear (Cambodia <u>v.</u> Thailand) (<u>Cambodia</u> v. <u>Thailand</u>), on Monday 30 and Tuesday 31 May 2011, at the Peace Palace in The Hague, the seat of the Court.

The hearings will be devoted to the request for the indication of provisional measures filed by Cambodia (see Press Release No. 2011/14).
