The following information from the Registry of the International Court of Justice is communicated to the Press:

The International Court of Justice has fixed Monday, 14 May 1962, 10.30 a.m. for the opening of the oral proceedings in the case of the Financial obligations of Members of the United Nations (Article 17, para. 2 of the Charter).

From information just received by the Registry, oral statements will be made by the representatives of the following Governments (in the order in which the Registry has received intimation of these statements):

Canada: represented by Mr. Marcel Cadieux, Assistant Under-Secretary and Legal Adviser to the Department of Foreign Affairs.

United States of America: represented by the Hon. Abram Chayes, Legal Adviser of the State Department.

Iran: represented by H.E. Dr. F. Adamyat, Iranian Ambassador to the Netherlands.

<u>Netherlands:</u> represented by Dr. W. Riphagen, Legal Adviser to the Ministry for Foreign Affairs.

<u>Italy:</u> represented by Professor Riccardo Monaco, Head of Diplomatic Affairs at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
