The following information from the Registry of the International Court of Justice has been communicated to the Press:

The Court will hold public hearings beginning Tuesday, February 28th, 1950, at 11.a.m. in the Advisory case concerning the interpretation of Peace Treaties signed with Bulgaria, Hungary and Romania.

The following Governments have availed themselves of the right to submit written statements on the same question: United States of America, United Kingdom, Bulgaria, Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Romania, Czechoslovakia, Australia and Hungary.
