Judgment to be delivered on 15 February 1995

The following information is communicated to the Press by the Registry of the International Court of Justice:

On <u>Wednesday 15 February 1995, at 10 a.m.</u>, the Court will hold a public sitting for the purpose of delivering its Judgment on jurisdiction and admissibility in the case concerning <u>Maritime Delimitation and</u> <u>Territorial Ouestions between Oatar and Bahrain</u>.

NOTE FOR THE PRESS

1. The public sitting will be held in the Great Hall of Justice of the Peace Palace. Members of the Press will be entitled to attend on presentation of an admission card, which may be obtained upon application. The tables reserved for them are situated on the far left of the public entrance of the courtroom.
