## <u>Application of the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide</u> (Bosnia and Herzegovina v. Serbia and Montenegro)

## Court to deliver its Judgment on Monday 26 February 2007 at 10 a.m.

## <u>The President of the Court will make a statement to the press</u> <u>immediately after the reading of the Judgment</u>

THE HAGUE, 12 February 2007. On Monday 26 February 2007, the International Court of Justice (ICJ), principal judicial organ of the United Nations, will deliver its judgment in the case concerning the <u>Application of the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide (Bosnia and Herzegovina v. Serbia and Montenegro)</u>.

A public sitting will be held at 10 a.m. in the Great Hall of Justice of the Peace Palace in The Hague, during which the President of the Court, Judge Rosalyn Higgins, will read the Court's Judgment.

Immediately after the public sitting, the President of the Court will make a statement to the media in the Small Hall of Justice of the Peace Palace.
