Land and Maritime Boundary between Cameroon and Nigeria (Cameroon v. Nigeria: Equatorial Guinea intervening)

<u>President of the Court to deliver a statement to the media immediately after</u> <u>the reading of the Judgment on Thursday 10 October 2002</u>

THE HAGUE, 9 October 2002. The International Court of Justice (ICJ), principal judicial organ of the United Nations, will deliver its Judgment on Thursday 10 October at 3 p.m. in the case of the Land and Maritime Boundary between Cameroon and Nigeria (Cameroon v. Nigeria: Equatorial Guinea intervening) at a public sitting as announced in Press Communiqué No. 2002/23 of 3 October 2002.

Immediately following the end of this sitting, the President of the Court, Judge Gilbert Guillaume, will deliver a statement to the media on the Court's Judgment. The reading of the Judgment will take place in the Great Hall of Justice in the Peace Palace in The Hague. The statement to the media will take place in the Small Hall of Justice.
